WHAT IS SPECIALIZED TRANSPORTATION?

Specialized transportation is a form of demand-response transport which often falls under the umbrella term paratransit. Specialized transportation is a term that describes any service along the transportation continuum between private automobile to fixed-route bus services, but specialized transportation services are targeted at people with mobility limitations caused by age or disability. Many individuals rely on several modes of specialized transportation to meet their needs.

Racine County recognizes the important role transportation plays in making sure our residents are receiving the services they need.
