What is Specialized Transportation?

Specialized transportation is a form of demand-response transport which often falls under the umbrella term paratransit. Specialized transportation is a term that describes any service along the transportation continuum between private automobile to fixed-route bus services., but specialized transportation services are targeted at people with mobility limitations caused by age or disability. Many individuals rely on several modes of specialized transportation to meet their needs.

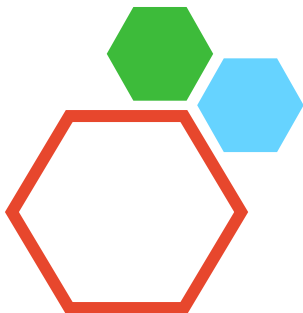
RYDE—Racine Transit

- Fixed Route, Curb to curb.
- Adults (18-64) & Youth (6-17) \$2.00
- Children (0-5) free
- Adults 65 and over, disabled \$1.00 (Approved application required or Medicare Card)

DIAL-A-RIDE (DART) *

- Door to door. Residents that are 60 years or older or have a disability and live within $\frac{3}{4}$ of mile of the RYDE service area.
- Must call by 2:00pm the day before the needed ride.
- Monday-Friday: 5am-11pm; Saturday: 5am-7pm, Sunday 9am-7pm

K-TOWN SPECIALIZED TRANSPORTATION *

- Door to door.
- Residents that are 65 years or older or have a disability and live outside the Bell Urban System service area.
- Reserve at least 24 hours in advance.
- Monday-Friday 5:30am– 6:00pm. Saturday dialysis only.
- Out of County Trips require authorization

- One week notice preferred; and at least 24 hours in advance.

- Flexible route and demand response.

Door to Door

The driver may go to the door and provide minimal assistance. This assistance **does not** include getting coats on, transferring in/out of wheelchair or getting individual into the correct room in a facility. The driver may not be out-of-sight of their vehicle.



Curb to Curb

The vehicle picks up the individual at the curb and drops them off at the curb. The driver may provide some assistance in and out of vehicle, but the rider must be ready at the curb and able to get from the curb into their destination.
