### Who Can Participate?

To qualify, the individual must:

- Be 60 years of age or older
- Be homebound
- Live in Racine County
- Be physically unable to obtain and prepare food themselves
- Have no one else available in the same household to prepare meals
- Be unable to attend a Senior Nutrition Site by car or special transportation
- Agree to be home when meals are delivered
- Be physically able to receive the meals by opening their door to drivers
- Be able to feed themselves

-  Modified for special diets
-  Home delivered on weekdays between 10:30am and 1pm
-  A donation invoice will be sent at the end of each month
-  Can be cancelled for a day or more with 48-hour notice
